Attention, student-athletes: How will you register with the NCAA Eligibility Center when you are ready to?

Do this during your junior year

Items you'll need when you register: pen, paper, social security number, fee waiver or a credit card for online payments—and a check or money order for mail in payments.

- **Step 1:** Go to ncaaclearinghouse.net.
- **Step 2:** Click on "Prospective Student-Athletes."
- **Step 3:** In the left margin, click on "Registration Form for U.S. Students."
- **Step 4:** Fill out your information.
- **Step 5:** Review all info. Click "Submit."
- **Step 6:** Click on "Amateurism Questionnaire" and complete.
- **Step 7:** Print payment form if you plan to pay by check. If you are paying online, don't print this page.
- **Step 8:** Print out the two forms, Copy 1 and Copy 2 (or save one for later). Copy 2 is for after you graduate from high school.
- **Step 9:** Request an official transcript from your high school. Ask if your school counselor can mail it for you with the form. NCAA prefers that the transcript be mailed directly from your high school.
- **Step 10:** Return to the Web site later, log in with your username and password, and check your status.

NCAA eligibility center fee waivers

Fee waivers are available for student-athletes whose families need and qualify for them. They make your NCAA Eligibility Center registration free.
